

## Microplastics Regulations (EU):

- **2023/2055 on synthetic polymer microparticles (SPM)**
- **2025/2365 on preventing plastic pellet losses to reduce microplastic pollution**

Please be informed that the products we sell are plastic granules which by nature are < 5 mm. Therefore, they are polymer microparticles according to **Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/2055** of 25 September 2023 amending Annex XVII to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH) as in regards to **synthetic polymer microparticles (SPM)**. However, please note that our plastic granules are processed by our customers into plastic molded parts through extrusion/injection moulding. Thus, our products are exempt from the restriction under paragraph 1 of the above Regulation, see paragraphs 4 a) and 5 c).

Please refer to our certificates for **Operation Clean Sweep**® (see link below), which we achieved in 2024 and for which we are recertified yearly.

The international program Operation Clean Sweep (OCS) was initiated by the international Plastics Industry Association (PLASTICS). Plastics Europe, the association of plastics manufacturers in Europe, and EuPC, the representative body of European plastics converters, have then launched a harmonized European certification system.

Since 2018, our company has been committed to actively contributing to environmental protection by minimizing pellet losses by implementing a Zero-Pellet-Loss-Program at its production sites.

Thus, we already

- implemented a risk management plan for each installation and keep it up to date
- installed the equipment and executed procedures described in the risk management plan
- took actions and are continuously improving them to effectively
  - o prevent spills,
  - o contain spills to avoid them becoming a loss,
  - o clean up after a spill or loss.


Furthermore, we are running an **environmental management system (EMS)** for our plants according to the international standard **ISO 14001**, as required in the regulation.
