

Battery Regulation (EU) 2023/1542 (EMRT)

The **Battery Regulation (EU) 2023/1542**, concerning batteries and waste batteries, amending Directive 2008/98/EC and Regulation (EU) 2019/1020, repealing Directive 2006/66/EC, **refers to active materials in battery cells**. According to the Regulation, 'active materials' are defined as materials that react chemically to produce electrical energy when the battery discharges, or to store electrical energy when the battery is charged. We hereby declare that **our products fall outside the scope** of this definition, meaning Regulation (EU) 2023/1542 does not apply to them.
